With the support of the department faculty, we are pleased to offer you a temporary appointment as Visiting Scholar in the Department of Plant & Soil Sciences, in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, at the University of Delaware. As a J-1 Exchange Visitor at the University of Delaware, you are required to comply with the Center for Global Programs and Services (CGPS) and Department of State regulations and policies.
