Dear Dr. Liu:

With the support of the department faculty, we are pleased to offer you a temporary appointment as Visiting Scholar in the Department of Plant and Soil Sciences, in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, at the University of Delaware. Your appointment in the Department of Plant and Soil Sciences will begin on September 16, 2024 and will end on September 15, 2026. As part of your program with the University of Delaware, you will receive a salary of \$61,000 (which includes full UD benefits).

Visiting Scholars are members of the academic staff who are appointed for a limited period of time during which they are actively involved in research and they are expected to contribute to the department in the form of lecturing, research, and/or consultation.

As part of your program with the Department of Plant and Soil Sciences, you will conduct research on the impact of sea-level rise and flooding on soil physical properties and hydrological processes within the scope of the projects Anticipating Threats to Natural Systems (ACTIONS) and Integrated Modeling for Predictive Analysis of Coastal Terrains (IMPACTS). This is a collaboration among the U.S. Army Engineer Research and Development Center Environmental Laboratory (ERDC), the University of Delaware (UD) and Louisiana State University (LSU). Dr. Yan Jin will work with you to establish performance goals that are part of your job responsibilities and you will be subject to periodic performance reviews. You will conduct your research at UD's ISE Lab, 221 Academy St., Newark, DE 19716 and the St Jones Reserve where we have established a long-term monitoring and sampling site for the project, and on as needed basis in other UD buildings that hold necessary research facilities.

As a J-1 Exchange Visitor at the University of Delaware, you are required to comply with the Center for Global Programs and Services (CGPS) and Department of State regulations and policies.
